“With God All Things Are Possible”

In a recent lesson from John 4:1-42, we learned how Jesus taught a Samaritan woman that He was the Savior of the world. Because He was talking to her at a well, He used the picture of water – living water that would quench her thirst forever – to show her just what kind of life and salvation He offered.

Jesus often used pictures to help His listeners grasp the amazing gifts of His love and grace. Five such pictures appear in the passages below. Read them with your child. Help each other understand what Jesus revealed about Himself in each picture.

John 10:9

“I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture.”

John 10:14-15

“I am the good shepherd . . . I lay down my life for the sheep.”

John 8:12

“I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but have the light of life.”

John 6:35

“I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry.”

John 15:5

“I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in Him, He will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.”



These pictures help us understand the wondrous gifts Jesus wants to give us: His love, His grace, His Word ... forgiveness, life, and salvation!

Your Child's Work

Grade updates and reports can be a good indicator of how your child is doing with work in school. What are other ways to monitor progress and improve classroom performance?

- ✚ Start the day with a good breakfast. Have your child exercise daily, eat a balanced diet, and get plenty of sleep.
- ✚ Look at homework papers. If you think they can do better, take the initiative to have them redo it.
- ✚ Ask your child what they are doing in particular classes. “What lesson are you studying in Bible History?” “What was chapel about today?” “Can you show me what you're doing in math?” “Tell me your memory work.” ...
- ✚ Look in their desks at school – it's interesting to discover what is in there.
- ✚ Speak positively about school, teachers, and other students in front of your own children and others. Your positive attitude will reflect on them, which shows in their class work and relationships with others.
- ✚ Limit television and video games to a set amount of time. Reading time at home can take its place.
- ✚ Set a regular time for study, in a quiet, well-lit place. Good study habits at home reflect at school as well.
- ✚ Involve your child in an extracurricular activity, e.g. soccer, dance, music lessons ... Research shows that students who are involved in such activities perform better in school.
- ✚ Include regular home devotions with God's Word every day, with plenty of opportunities for prayer.
- ✚ Spend quality time with the family. Hug your children, pray for them, and remind them of Jesus' promises of forgiveness and heaven.
